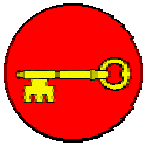

Site has been confirmed and reserved. The theme will be Winter Revelry and the color scheme is blue and red. Contacting motels/hotels in the area to confirm discount deal.

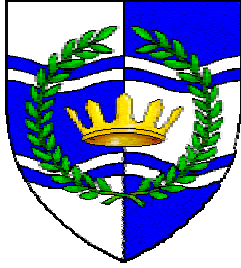
