Marshal Report:

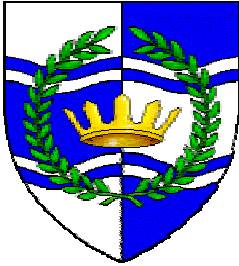
Seeking list of warranted marshals.
