Lidia's name and device passed Kingdom.

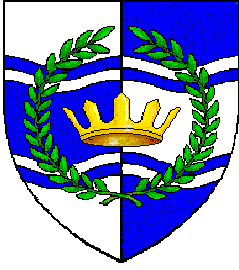
New Business:
