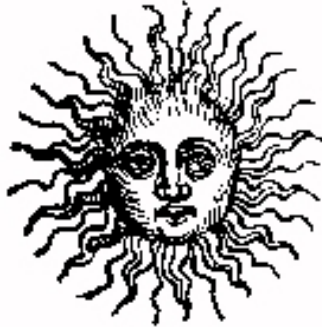

I have received confirmation on my warrant as of turning in my information at Unevent.

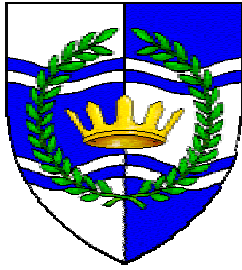
