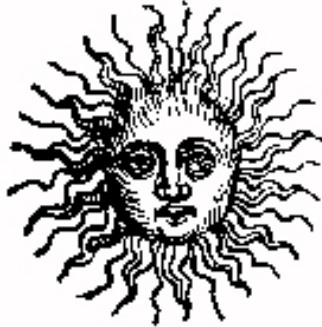

Volunteers to meet next Thursday (2/12/04).

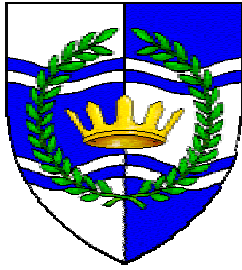
Kaleigh running troll. Brought up that financial policy states that a member of the canton must be at troll at all times.
