#### **Cake**

A flat, round loaf of sweet bread, described in the *Prologue to The Canterbury Tales* as being similar in shape and size to a buckler, the Medieval round shield.

#### **Neet**

Cattle. "His lordes sheep, his neet, his dayerye" - Prologue to The Canterbury Tales

#### **Walshnote**

Walnut. Nuts played an enormous role in Medieval diet and walnuts were among the many sorts of nuts that were constantly kept on hand in larger kitchens. They also had the added value of being able to be made, like almonds, into both a milk and an oil.

#### **Ale**

An alcoholic beverage similar to but more bitter than beer.

#### **Olyve**

Olive tree, olive trees

#### **Keen**

Cows; the plural of the Middle English word *kine*.

#### **Feeste**

Feast, banquet; also revelry, festival, celebration, joy, rejoicing, etc. In addition, this word was also used as a gesture of welcome, to show respect, to pay a compliment, and to express pleasure.

#### **Sugre**

Sugar.

#### **Pye**

Meat or fish pie.

#### **Kechyl**

A little cake.

#### **Potage**

A thick soup.

#### **Quayles**

Quails; a large game fowl related to pheasants and grouse.

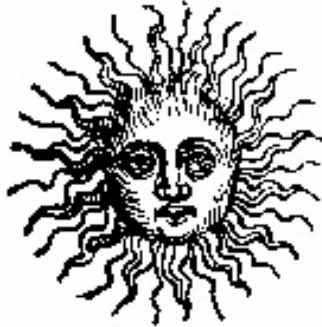

Possibly going to combine Wednesday night project night with the Sunday fighter practice.

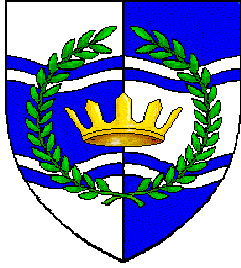
Current Project List for Wednesday Nights:
