Fighting – Both heavy and rapier fighters will enjoy rousing **tourneys**, followed by a **boastful challenge contest**, where they can bring their own heralds to make their fetes of bravery and deeds of chivalry known beyond a doubt to the populace. The winners of these challenges of boast and wit will be determined by ladies’ choice. Competitions for our archers will be held, as well.

Arts & Sciences – Two A&S competitions will be held at the Mermaid. The site is once again Camp Loy White, 258 Hull Road, Casar, NC 28020. Site opens at 10:00 am and closes at 10:00 p.m. This site is **Absolutely Bone Dry**. *Anyone who has alcohol on site will be asked to leave and will not get a refund of their event fee.* Sorry, no pets allowed.

As per SCA policy, **minors** must be accompanied by their parents who have signed a waiver for them, or minors must have a minor waiver signed by their parent to turn in when they check in, even if they have a membership card. Minors without waivers cannot be permitted to attend the event.

Directions

From I-40 East or West: Take NC Hwy. 18 towards Shelby. Turn Right on NC Hwy. 10 towards Casar, go about 8 miles, turn Left onto St. Paul's Church Rd., go 2 miles, turn Right on Hull Rd., go ½ mile, Camp Loy White is on the Left.

From I-85 North or South: Take US Hwy. 74 to Shelby, follow Business 74 to the right, after 1.5 miles go north (Right) on NC Hwy. 180. After 5.1 miles turn right on NC Hwy. 18. Go approx. 9 miles & turn Left on Carpenter's Grove Road (there is a sign for Camp Loy White and also one for Belwood Community Center at this intersection). Go 2.5 miles. Turn Left on St. Paul's Church Rd., go 2 miles and turn Left on Hull Rd. Go ½ mile, then Left into Camp Loy White.

Available to publish member pages.

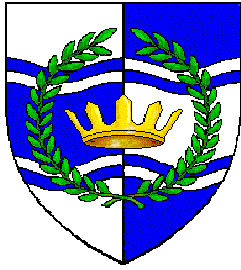
Old Business:
