Upon hearing this, she announced that she would be beautiful all the time because he had respected her enough to let her be in charge of her own life.

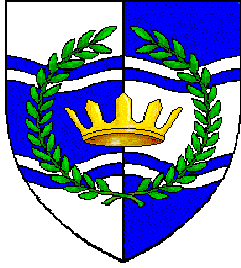
Now... what is the moral to this story?
